- 3. Develop a list of shelters (to share with a person who needs a place to stay)
- 4. Bring food: carry snacks or a sandwich while out doing errands to share with a person living on the street.
- 5. Give money to organizations that serve the homeless.
- 6. Donate clothing to organizations that serve the homeless.
- 7. Donate groceries to a local shelter or food drive.
- 8. Volunteer at a shelter.
- 9. Volunteer at a soup kitchen.
- 10. Advocate by getting involved in your local community.
